Jewel Johnson's classical dance training began in September, 2017 at the Caribbean School of Dancing.

Her journey with the Metamorphosis Dance company took place from 2018 when she joined as an apprentice, to 2020. She danced in the company's yearly showcase, "Take Heart", in 2019.

Jewel attended the Joffrey Ballet School Miami Summer Intensive in 2018 and the Joffrey Ballet School New York Jazz and Contemporary Summer Intensive, on a full scholarship in 2019. This year she was accepted into the Institute for American Musical Theatre on a full scholarship. The program lasts for two years and trains all students in the art of dancing (Ballet, Musical Theatre, Modern, Commercial Jazz and Tap), singing and acting. After completing this program, she hopes to begin her career on Broadway, Film and TV to fulfill a lifelong dream.
